CW: Transfer Your Drawing

- Place the carbon paper so that the lead is facing the linoleum block.
- Take the drawing and flip it over onto your linoleum block so that the pencil marks are face down on the block. Remember the letters need to be backwards STILL.
- Tape down the drawing. You want it to stay in place.
- Trace over your drawing from the back. Go over every line, dot, and shading.
- Lift the carbon paper and drawing paper off the block. The process of tracing should have transferred your design to the surface of the block.
- Put the drawing aside.
- Using a sharpie marker, trace your pencil lines. These sharpie lines will stay on while you carve. They will not show up with your print after you apply ink.
